- Online streaming video can be watched directly on the webpage.
- Windows Media Player format (WMV video file)
- Apple QuickTime Player format (MOV video file)
- iPod/iPhone format (M4V video file)
- Audio-only format (MP3 audio file)

Should I download the free files from the Video Room or purchase CDs/DVDs?

These free digital downloads are intended for personal use and not intended for display on a larger screen. All of our videos are available in high resolution DVD format and can be purchased in our online store.

How do I download a file?

Downloading files requires a broadband internet connection such as cable, DSL or speed equivalent.

Use your mouse to right-click on the file you want to download, then click "Save Target As" (Internet Explorer) or "Save Link As" (Mozilla Firefox). Proceed as you normally would to save a file to a folder on your computer.

What software do I need to play these files?

WMV video files play best on <u>Windows Media Player</u>, but will play on other media players as well. The Macintosh OS does not natively support the WMV format, but there is a "Mac Version" of Windows Media Player.

MOV video files play best on Apple's Quicktime Media Player, but will play on other media players as well.

M4V video files are intended for use on iPods, iPhones, and iTunes.

MP3 files (audio-only) will play on almost any audio player.
