Watch massive tarpons swim alongside the barracuda and other shell fish species such as Caribbean lobsters and conch at the Fish Nursery. Visit Paradise Point at the top of First Bight Community. Enjoy stunning views of the whole island surrounded by the world-famous

barrier reef. From here you'll visit Las Palmas Beach Village in Dixon's Cove for a beach break or stroll around the wide selection of artisan shops.

Stop at one of the oldest Methodist churches on Roatan for a photo opportunity, where your guide will share the local island history with you.

Drive up the top of "El Mirador", the highest point of Coxen Hole Harbor and enjoy a great view of the island's beautiful coastline. At the Rum Cake Factory you'll sample the sweet cakes and then enjoy a refreshment at the Half Moon Restaurant. From there, your drive takes you through the hills of Roatan to the West End to admire the architecture and beautiful homes of Sandy Bay. On your return to the terminal, you'll pass Monkey Hill road and see the monkey sculptures.

JOLLY ROGER CATAMARAN SAILING & SNORKELING WITH LUNCH

Your adventure begins at the cruise ship pier, where you'll be met by your Captain and crew. After a scenic 30 minute bus transfer get ready to board your waiting 60 foot, modern, sailing catamaran. After a short safety briefing, you'll set sail along the scenic coast of Roatan in stunning turquoise Caribbean waters. During your sail to the snorkeling point, you'll be fitted with your snorkeling equipment and given safety instructions. There is plenty of room to stretch out on the forward sun deck and ample comfortable shaded seating. There's also a bar serving soft drinks and purified water before snorkeling. After approximately one half hour, you'll arrive at the snorkeling point.

Snorkeling here is about the best the Caribbean has to offer. Enter the crystal clear, warm water, via the center stair case. Get an up close view of beautiful living coral and a large variety of tropical reef fish. All levels of snorkeler's, novice, intermediate and advanced snorkeler's will enjoy this site. Your snorkel guides will direct you to the best areas and make sure you are comfortable. After all snorkeling is finished (approximately 60 minutes) you're invited aboard to enjoy unlimited rum punch, rum drinks, fruit punch, soft drinks and a rotisserie roast chicken lunch with rice, pasta salad, cabbage salad and fresh fruit in season. Kick back and relax, listen to Caribbean music as you sail to the disembarkation point for your return transfer to your ship, approximately 30 minutes. One of the crew will accompany you back to the ship and be happy to answer any questions about Roatan & Honduras.

SOUTH SHORE ZIPLINE ADVENTURE

Enjoy the thrill of a 12-line canopy adventure with magnificent views of the Caribbean Sea! Your day of adventure begins at the pier when you're greeted by your friendly guide. Board your air-conditioned transfer for a 25 minute drive through towns and villages on the island. Your guide will share with you important information about the culture, nature and people of Roatan.

Upon arrival to the South Shore Canopy site, you'll be geared up with safety equipment, receive a safety briefing and then have your first photo opportunity. Once everyone is geared up and familiar with the safety regulations, you're ready for your adventure. The longest run is 1,300 feet, the highest point is 100 feet, and the total line length is about 2 miles. DOLPHIN ENCOUNTER

Your dolphin encounter in Roatan takes place in a natural setting that resembles a Tahitian island village. The resort is laid out on two small keys, one of which is the private home to a large family of Atlantic bottlenose dolphins. The best of both worlds - SNUBA® bridges the gap between snorkeling and diving and is a perfect activity for children and adults alike, requiring no certification. Explore Roatan's spectacular underwater world via a 20 foot air-line connected to a standard scuba tank on the water's surface. The tank moves with you, and you get to breathe underwater without the constraints of heavy dive gear. Your guide will give you instructions in shallow water. Afterwards, you'll be able to SNUBA on the designated trail. It is about 50 yards of sea grass where one can often see starfish, sting rays, octopus and juvenile fish. Past the sea grass, you'll find the coral reef with a spectrum of tropical fish. No prior experience is needed. Actual SNUBA time is approximately 45 minutes and depends on your usage of air.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. Due to restrictions by the Dive Provider, any SNUBA participants currently taking any medication or with a previous medical condition should bring a note from their primary physician stating that they are medically cleared to participate on a SCUBA/SNUBA excursion. Due to safety concerns Pregnant women are restricted from participation.

Head out to the second largest barrier reef in the world to learn about Roatan's history underwater. Yes, you'll actually learn about it while snorkeling the pristine, calm waters just inside the reef as you visit the Underwater Museum. The coral garden will showcase the abundant marine life on the island. Roatan's history goes back to the Maya civilization, and travels through time witnessing the arrival of the Conquistadores, the Garifuna and the fishing industry. During your tour today, you'll visit the Underwater Museum which showcases artifacts from each of those periods - including the remains of a sunken Spanish galleon - all surrounded by beautiful coral gardens on the barrier reef. After departing the pier on the way to the museum, your friendly guide will provide you with very useful and important information about the island.

Upon arrival at the museum, you'll receive a safety briefing and your snorkel equipment and will head out to the beach for your snorkel tour.
